The Home

The home has undergone significant updates including new bedrooms and bathrooms and hardwood floors.

The main level has a large eat-in kitchen which opens to a large deck with built-in bbq station with granite counter and pergola for shade.

Alongside the kitchen is the dining room which opens directly onto the deck.

The living room has lovely views through over-sized picture windows, built-in seating and a wood-burning fireplace. Next to the living room is a wood storage room and a solarium for growing plants.

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On the west side of the main floor is a den and home office plus a 2-piece powder room.

Also on this level is a tiled foyer and mudroom.

Upstairs

The second floor can accommodate 2 or 3 bedrooms and has 2 renovated bathrooms. The large master suite has hardwood floors, built-in desk, a large change room and a well renovated 3-piece bathroom with over-sized shower.

The second bedroom has hardwood floors, closet and a semi en suite 4-piece bathroom which has been renovated.
